NCLL Safety Plan

Code of Conduct

- No smoking or drinking alcohol ever on school premises
- No pets without leash
- No playing in parking lots
- Must have driver's license to drive utility vehicle or lawn mower
- No swinging of bats or throwing of baseballs within common area
- No rock throwing, climbing fences³³/trees
- Walk bikes / scooters
- Clean up trash in dugout and around stands
- Gates to the field must be closed at all times, except when coming and going

Safety Code- Injury Prevention



- ***Eat health and hydrated:*** Players can only have water or sports drinks during a game. No food or seeds in the dugout.
- ***Prepare to Play:*** Warm up, stretch, fundamentals. This year managers and coaches CAN warm up the pitcher
- ***Inspections:*** Field inspection, facilities, and equipment

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Safety Code- Injury Prevention



Weather Conditions

- **Air Quality** - $AQI \geq 151$ games and practices will be canceled
- **Extreme Heat:** If HeatRisk level is “Major” (Red/Level 3) or “Extreme” (Magenta/Level 4) games and practices will be canceled
- **Thunder & Lightning:** Halt Activities if:
 - Lightning seen
 - Thunder is heard (storm is within 10 miles)
 - Time between lightning and thunder is 30 seconds or less (storm is less than 6 miles away)

Category	Risk of Heat-Related Impacts
Green 0	Little to no risk from expected heat.
Yellow 1	Minor - This level of heat affects primarily those individuals extremely sensitive to heat, especially when outdoors without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.
Orange 2	Moderate - This level of heat affects most individuals sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration. Impacts possible in some health systems and in heat-sensitive industries.
Red 3	Major - This level of heat affects anyone without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration. Impacts likely in some health systems, heat-sensitive industries and infrastructure.
Magenta 4	Extreme - This level of rare and/or long-duration extreme heat with little to no overnight relief affects anyone without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration. Impacts likely in most health systems, heat-sensitive industries and infrastructure.



Safety Code- Injury Prevention

Batting Cages



- At least 2 adults must be present
 - 1 coach to feed balls
 - 1 adult to supervise outside of cage
- No more than 2 players allowed inside cage
 - 1 batter
 - 1 player waiting behind safety fence
 - Other players need to be physically distanced
 - Cage door must be closed³⁶
- All players with a bat in their hand **MUST** be wearing a helmet
- If using pitching machine, helmet must have a face mask attached
- **NO** swinging of bats outside of batting cage...ever!



Safety Code- Injury Prevention



Gear



- Protective cup must be worn by male players.
- Catchers must wear helmet with mask and throat guard, chest protector, shin guards
- Batters must wear³⁷ Little League approved helmets and use approved bats.
- Use bats on field and batting cages.

Emergency Procedures



- Stop all play and quickly assess the injured/ill
Get medical release form to check for medical conditions
- If needed, call 911/get AED (in Minor Field Score Booth)
 - EMS should be directed to Vallejo Mills Elementary School, 38569 Canyon Heights Dr. OR Oranewood (by snack shack)
 - Contact player's parents
 - Manage players/crowd
 - Direct EMS
 - Fire Extinguishers: In Snack Shack
 - Emergency Phone Numbers, Board Member Contact Info, and directions to Field will be posted in all Score Booths and in the Snack Shack

ALL medical/first aid situations, need to have a Injury/Incident Form completed

Feeling Sick / Injured



1. If player, managers, coaches, volunteers feel ill stay home
2. Returning from Injuries require medical clearance

Background Checks

- 2 Steps:
 - JDP Online Background Checks
 - Photo ID for Verification

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Abuse Awareness Training

- Online Training
- Required for all volunteers
- Must use the Little League Abuse Awareness Training
 - Create Account to link to Data Center

Livescan

- Volunteers who have direct contact with or supervise youth **more than 16 hours a month or 32 hours a year** (CA Business and Professions Code, Division 8, Chapter 2.9)
- Cost of fingerprints covered by NCLL
- Even if you were fingerprinted somewhere else, that is for that organization, you must complete it through NCLL
- This is done once while at NCLL
- NCLL is required to receive updated alerts should a subsequent event occur involving the volunteer that would generate a notice from CA Department of Justice
- If a member leaves NCLL, notify the Custodian of Records, so that member can be removed
 - *Current Custodian of Records: Rosie Benin-Safety Officer*

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Livescan

Required to LiveScan for NCLL:

- Board member, Managers, Coaches
- Non-voting board members with consistent field presence
- Home plate umpires (substitutes who will not reach the legal hour requirement for LiveScan can be exempted at the direction of the League President)
- On-field volunteers (practice and/or games)
- Safety parent/bleacher parent
- Snack Shack Supervisors

NOT required to LiveScan:

- Scorekeepers
- Volunteer base umpires
- Team parents
- Snack shack volunteers
- Field maintenance/field prep crew

Recap

- Safety Plan - On NCLL Website or Hard Copy in the Snack Shack
- Player and Spectator Safety
 - No swinging bats / Bats down - Helmets on
 - No rock throwing, no climbing fence/trees
 - No playing in parking areas
 - Parents should make sure that Manager/Coaches are there
 - No child left at the field

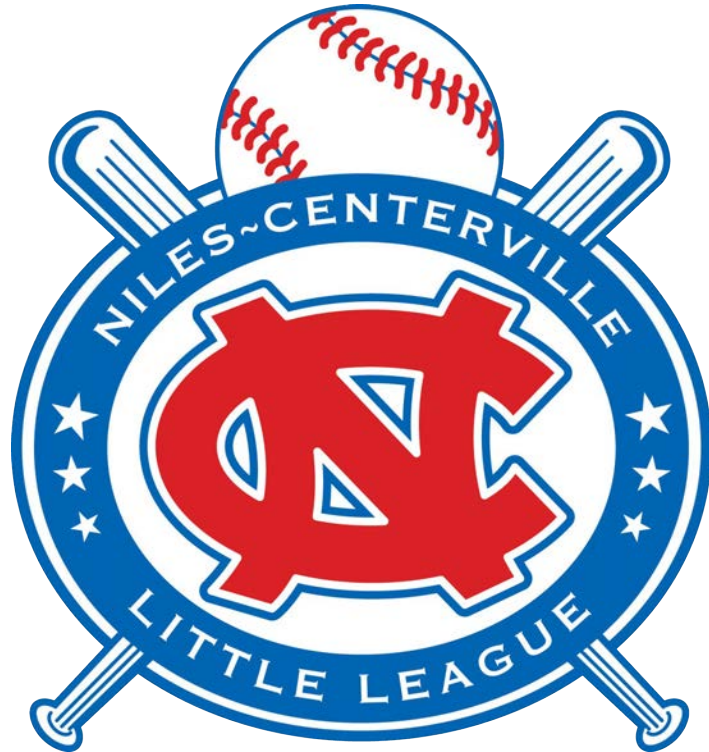
